- Great resume builder
- Leads to Career Opportunities
- Money roller Stipend
- Offered to ALL fields
- External funding offered by
 - Government
 - Federal agencies
 - Corporations

Tips for Applying to Graduate Fellowships

- Develop a Strategic Plan
- Read others' people proposals
- Review the web site funding agency
- Write the fellowship application one month is advance
- Ask faculty, research members, employees, and career office to read your application
- Turn your application in at least three days before deadline

NSF Graduate Research Fellowship

- Fellowship three years over five years
- Awarded to students who pursue STEM degree
- Stipend and cost of education allowance
- NSF encourages women, minority groups, veterans, and people with disabilities
- National Science Foundation East Asia and Pacific Summer Institutes (NSF-EAPSI)
 - Students receive a \$5,000 stipend and international roundtrip airfare and opportunity to do first hand research abroad.

Ford Foundation Fellowship

- Ford Foundation offers Predoctoral, Doctoral, and Post-Doctoral
- Offered to individuals granted deferred action status under the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals Program, regardless of race, national origin, religion, gender, age, disability, or sexual orientation.
- Individuals committed to a career in teaching and research at the college or university level.
- Required to attend Conference of Ford Fellows
- Offer a Ford Foundation INTERNATIONAL

NDSEG Graduate Fellowship

- Fellowships are for three year tenures and include full tuition and fees, a competitive stipend, and a health insurance allowance.
- Sponsored by government
 - Army Research Office

 - DoD High Performance Computing Modernization
 Program

DAGSI Graduate Fellowship

- Supports graduate science and engineering students and faculty who conduct research at WPAFB
- A two-person team comprised of a graduate student and a faculty member
- Each student is required to spend a minimum of eight consecutive weeks conducting research at Wright-Patterson AFB.

International Fellowships

Ford Foundation International Fellowship

- Fellows will be selected from countries in Africa and the Middle East,
 Asia, Latin America, and Russia where the foundation maintains active overseas program
- The IFP provides support for up to three years of formal graduate-level study

Facebook Fellowship

- The fellowship covers full tuition and provides a stipend to full time PhD students
- Several Benefits
 - Paid internship at Facebook
 - Paid visit to Facebook HQ to present your research
 - \$2,500 for personal computer and equipment
- Cost of education allowance is accepted

Exciting Fellowships

- Google US/Canada PhD Fellowship Program
 - Two-year fellowships consisting of tuition and fees, yearly stipend, a Google Research Mentor, and possible third year extension at Google's discretion

- IBM PhD Fellowship
 - Honors exceptional Ph.D. students who have an interest in solving problems that are important to IBM
 - Students from Europe and Russia may be nominated in their first year of study in their doctoral program. Outside of Europe and Russia, students must have completed at least one year of study in their doctoral program at the time of their nomination
 - Faculty can contact IBM collegue before being nominated to ensure interest

 - Must be seeking their first national laboratory appointment (no previous postdoctoral appointments at a national laboratory)
